9.	08.05.2026	<u>VS,J</u> Though the order was passed on 30.09.2022, the respondents have not complied with the orders passed by this Court till date. But, however, it is brought to the notice of this Court that the respondents have preferred a writ appeal against the order passed by this Court in W.A.No.451 of 2023. Admittedly, no interim order has been passed in the said appeal and the same is pending since 2023. Under the guise of pendency of the writ appeal, the respondents have failed to comply with the orders passed by this Court. It can be observed that, in the meanwhile, the officers have been transferred and are now taking advantage of the fact that they are no longer the respondents. In view of the same, as the officers impleaded as respondents/contemnors in the present contempt case were the officers holding the posts as on the date of passing of the order by this Court, this Court is of the opinion that the said respondents are responsible for compliance with the orders.
