Heard Sri K.Siva Sai Chandra Subash, learned counsel for appellants, Ms.Padmavathi Padnavis, learned counsel, and Sri K.Koteswara Rao, learned counsel for respondents. It is stated that appellants had initially filed writ petition challenging the impugned orders and ultimately, the same came to be dismissed by holding that only appeal is maintainable and not writ petition. Thereby, in the process there is a delay in preferring present appeals. Already this Court considering aforesaid aspect in other connected appeals, delay has been condoned. Having regard to the reasons assigned in affidavit filed in support of these applications and considering that appellants had been bonafidely prescribed writ petition before this Court, these applications are ordered and delay is condoned.
