02.	12.05.2023	<u>BSB, J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2023</u> This application has been filed by the petitioner/A1 to suspend the sentence imposed against him, <i>vide</i> judgment, dated 09.03.2023, in S.C.No.245 of 2016 on the file of the Court of VIII Additional District & Sessions Judge, Prakasam District, at Ongole, and to enlarge the petitioner/A1 on bail. The present appeal is preferred by A1 aggrieved by the judgment, dated 09.03.2023, passed in S.C.No.245 of 2016, whereby, the petitioner/A1 was found guilty for the offence punishable under Section 304-B IPC and sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for seven years. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/A1 and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent/State. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has fair chances of success in the appeal as the judgment impugned is unsustainable to base a conviction against the petitioner/accused. It is further submitted that the petitioner is at present lodged in District Jail, Ongole. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor opposed the petition.	

A perusal of the judgment impugned shows that the accused allowed the deceased to drive her for self immolation. Considering the seriousness of the offence and the material on record, this Court is of the view that the petitioner is not entitled for passing of any favourable orders.

Accordingly, I.A.No.1 of 2023 stands dismissed.
