Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner(s) and the learned counsel for the respondent/accused. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that because of severe health issues faced by the complainant they could not prefer the appeal within time. There is a delay of 14 days. Learned counsel would further submit that a fair opportunity may be given to the complainant to pursue this appeal. Per contra, learned counsel for the respondent/accused would submit that the petitioner has failed to follow the procedure as per the Rules	

		for filing additional affidavit in support of their contention to condone the delay. Learned counsel during the course of arguments would further submit that the Court may pass appropriate orders by imposing a condition that the petitioner has to submit their arguments on the date to be fixed by the Court without fail. Considering the submissions made and a fair look at the material placed on record, though the reason for delay is not supported by any Medical record, in the interest of justice, as the complainant wanted to challenge the validity and correctness of the impugned Judgment of acquittal passed in C.C.No.69 of 2016, the petition is allowed subject to the petitioner/appellant shall submit their arguments on the next date of hearing without fail, failing which, the petition shall stand dismissed. <u>Crl.A.No.375 of 2023</u> List the matter on 26.06.2025.
