AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Jada Sravan Kumar, Advocate for the Petitioners and of Public Prosecutor for Respondent Nos.1 to 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds filed in Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in Crime No. 11/2023, dated 28/01/2023 on the file of the Komiligundla PS, Nandyal Dist, registered for the offence U/Sec 354, 323, 342, 506, 509, 420 r/w 34 of IPC against the petitioner including the appearance till the disposal of the Main Quash Petition in the interest of the justice, pending disposal of CRLP No.1024 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

In the meanwhile, Police concerned are directed to follow the procedure contemplated under Section 41A Cr.P.C., scrupulously.

Post the matter after four (4) weeks.”
