In the meanwhile, the presence of the petitioners before the trial Court is dispensed with, except on the dates where the learned Magistrate feels that their presence is necessary.

List the matter after six (6) weeks.

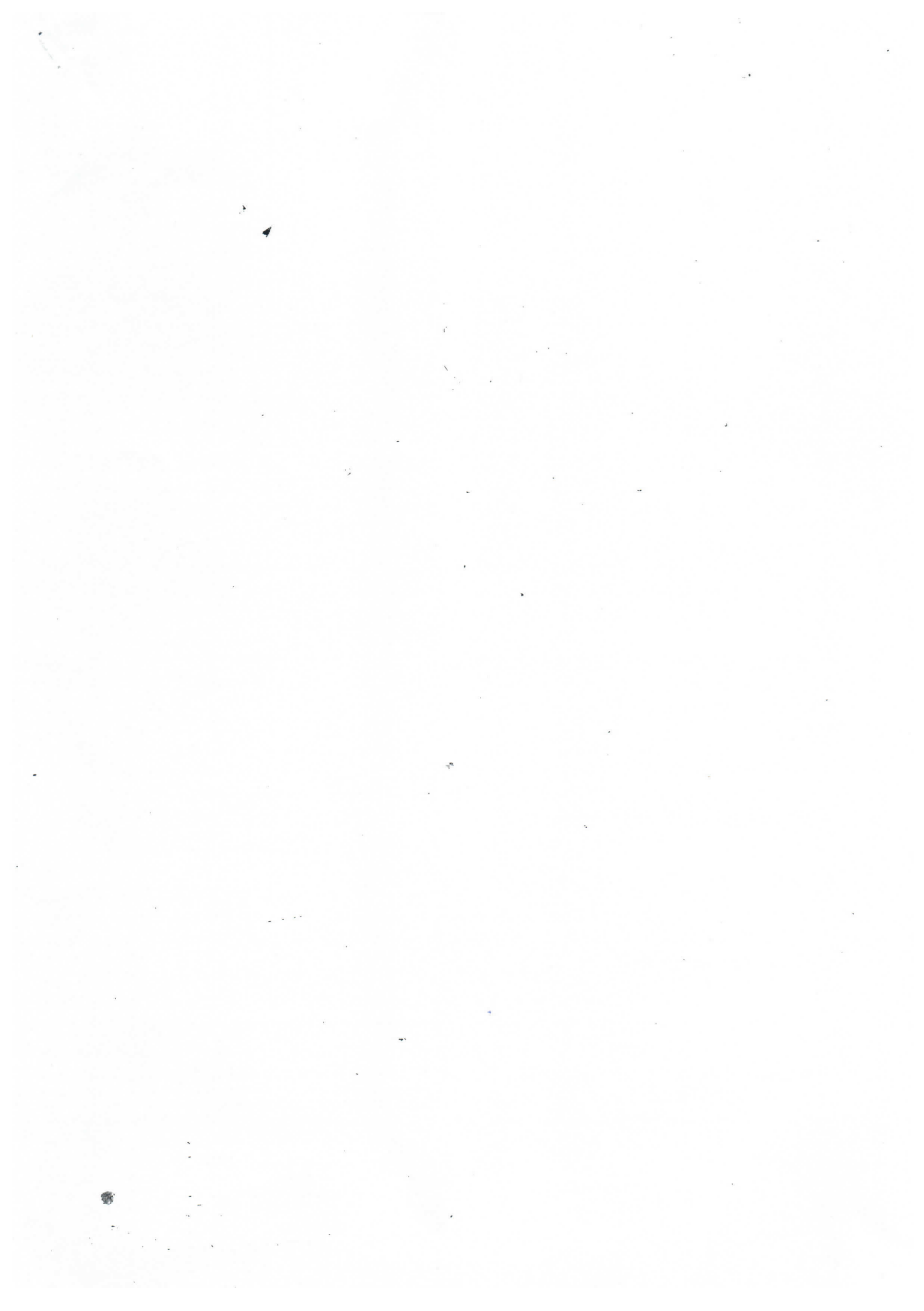
