List the matter after six (6) weeks."

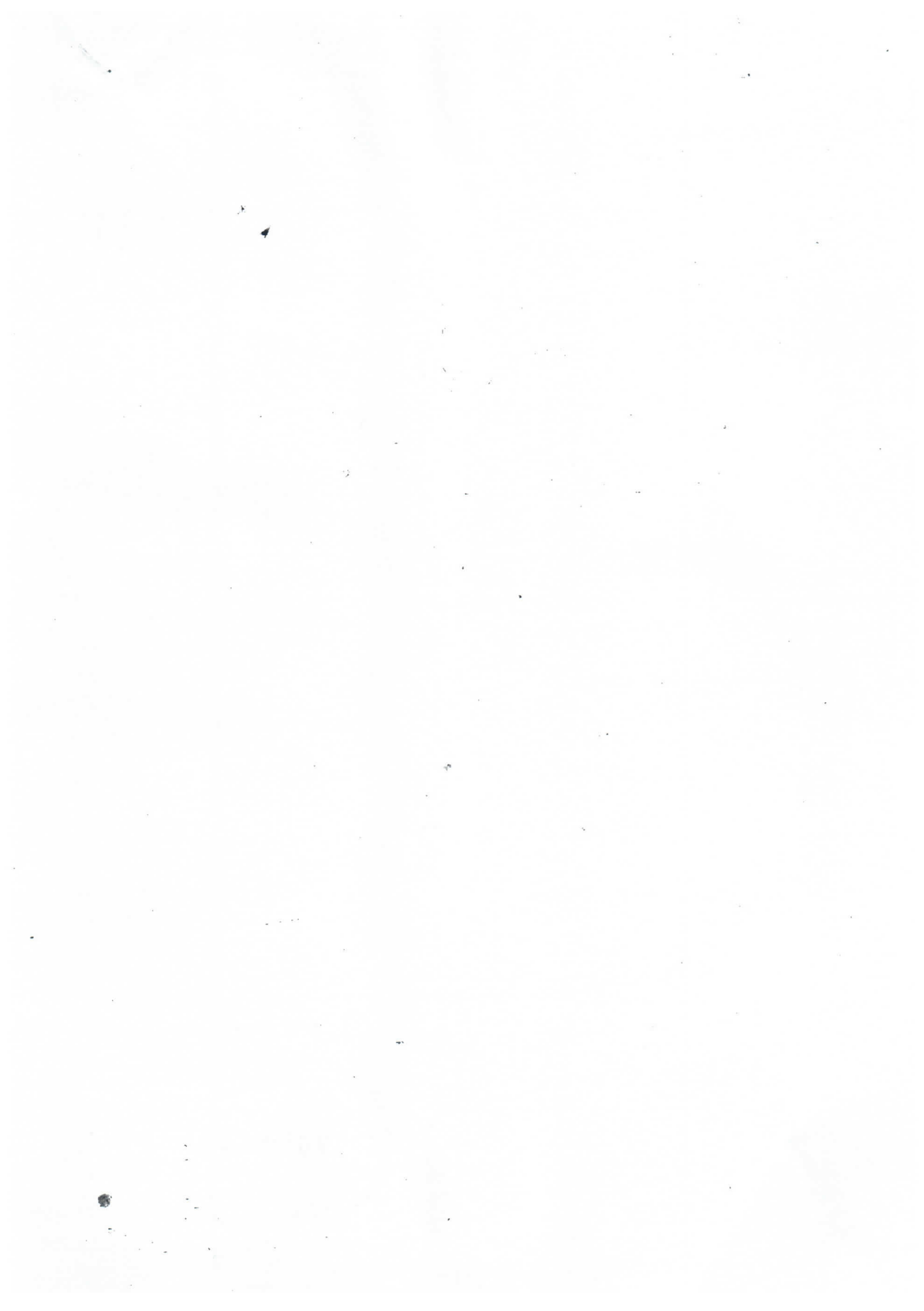
