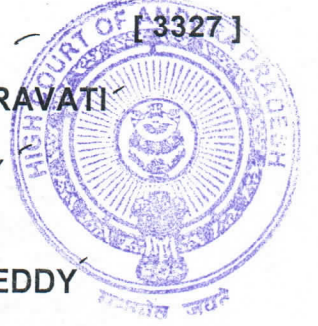

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri S S Bhatt Advocate for the Petitioner, Assistant Public Prosecutor for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings against the Petitioners/Accused No. 1 to 4, in C.C.No. 931/2022 on the file of the court of the I addl.junior civil judge proddatur, respect of FIR No.61/2022, 28.03.2022 of Proddatur III Town P.S., Kadapa District, registered U/Secs.498-A and 34 IPC and r/w Sec.3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, , pending disposal of CRLP No. 1306 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by RPAD and file proof of service in the Registry within a period of three (3) weeks.

In the meanwhile, the presence of the petitioners 2 to 4 herein/A2 to A4 only before the trial Court is dispensed with, except on those dates where the learned Magistrate feels that their presence is necessary, for a period of eight (8) weeks. ✓ It is needles to mention here that petitioner No.1 herein/A1 shall attend before the trial Court for all adjournments on behalf of A2 to A4 also.

List the matter after six (6) weeks.” ✓
