Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor takes notice for the respondent No.1 and seeks time to get instructions in the matter.

Issue notice to respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by RPAD and file proof of service in the Registry within a period of three (3) weeks.

The accusation as against the petitioner herein is that he forged the signature of one Y. karuna and submitted the documents before the Manager, AP State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited. On a perusal of the memo of evidence attached to the charge sheet goes show that LWs.1 to 7 were examined, however, the said karuna has not been examined to show that her signatures were forged by the petitioner herein and the same needs further examination.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, there shall be interim stay of all further proceedings in CC No.641 of 2021 on the file learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Palasa, for a period of eight (8) weeks.

List the matter after six (6) weeks.
