Petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C, praying that in the circumstances stated in the memorandum of grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner /accused No.1 in the event of his arrest in Crime No 407 of 2022 on the file of Dharmavaramu I Town Police Station, Sri Satya Sai District

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the memo of grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri E ANJANA REDDY, Advocate for the Petitioner, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, Advocate for the Respondent and the Court made the following

ORDER:

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE K. SREENIVASA REDDY**CRIMINAL PETITION NO.138 OF 2023****ORDER:-**

The Criminal Petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed on behalf of the petitioner/ Accused No.1 to grant anticipatory bail in connection with Crime No.407 of 2022 of Dharmavaram I Town Police Station, Sri Sathya Sai District.

2) A case has been registered against the petitioner and another for the offence punishable under Section 324, 307 r/w 34 IPC.

3) Brief facts of the case are that, on 27.11.2022, some altercation took place between de facto complainant and A1 at Muntimadugu Village, Garladinne mandal, and in that connection, on 29.11.2022 at 09.00 A.M., while complainant was going for morning walk near Sivalayam, Siva Nagar, Dharmavaram Town, A1 and A2 attacked him with sickle and stone with intent to kill and caused bleeding injuries. The complainant was shifted to Government Hospital, Dharmavaram for treatment by his son-in-

law. Basing on the medical intimation and statement of complainant, the case was registered against the accused.

4) Heard. Perused the record.

5) It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the alleged incident is said to have taken place in a spur of the moment. A perusal of FIR goes to show that the petitioner herein had hit the de facto complainant with a stone and thereafter the petitioner along with A2 had beat the de facto complainant with hands and legs, resulting in simple injuries to him. It is reported by the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor that major portion of investigation is completed.

6) In view of the facts and circumstances of the case that since major portion of investigation is completed, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

7) Accordingly, the petitioner shall surrender before the Station House Officer concerned within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and on such surrender, the petitioner shall be released on bail on executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only), with two sureties for the

like sum to the satisfaction of the arresting police officials and the petitioner shall make himself available for investigation as and when required and that he shall not cause any threat, inducement or promise to the prosecution witnesses.

The petitioner shall appear before the Station House Officer, concerned, once in a week i.e., on every Sunday between 10.00 a.m. and 05.00 p.m. till filing of the charge sheet.

8) Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed.

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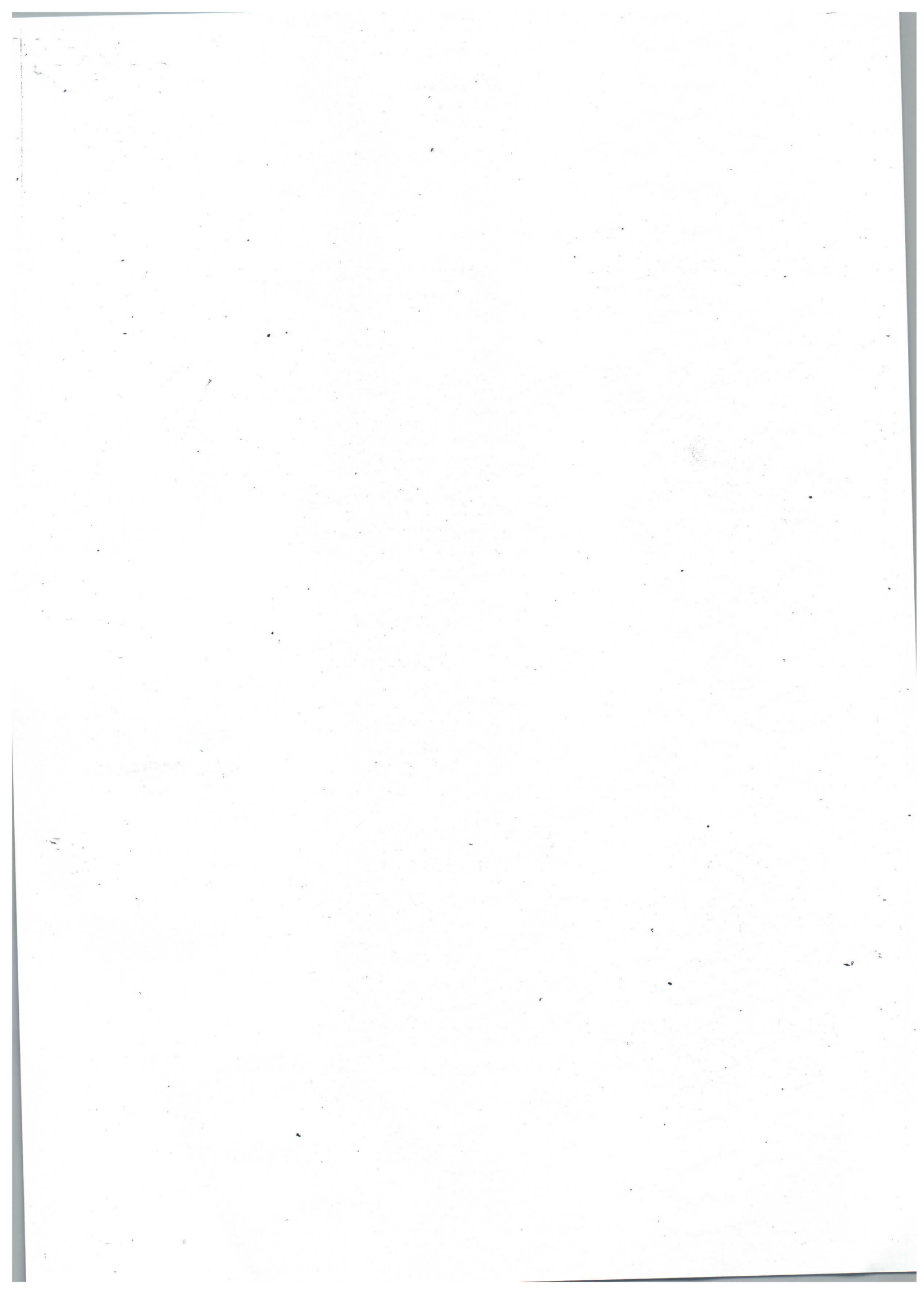
