The learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to the 2nd respondent by RPAD and file proof of service by the next date of hearing. Post on 17.02.2023. The petitioners are accused in C.C.No.332 of 2022 on the file of the Principal Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate of I Class, Eluru, West Godavari District, for the offence under Section 498-A & 506 r/w. 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act. The petitioners contend that the allegations made against them in the charge sheet are general and omnibus allegations without any details as to specifics and as such, no case can be made against them. A perusal of the charge sheet does show	

		that there are no specific allegations against the petitioners except general and omnibus allegations of harassment. In the circumstances, the presence of the petitioners shall be dispensed with, till further orders in C.C.No.332 of 2022 on the file of the Principal Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate of I Class, Eluru, West Godavari District, except when their presence is required for examination.
