In the meanwhile, the police concerned are directed to conduct investigation without taking any coercive steps against the petitioner herein including his arrest, for a period of eight (8) weeks.

List the matter after six (6) weeks.”

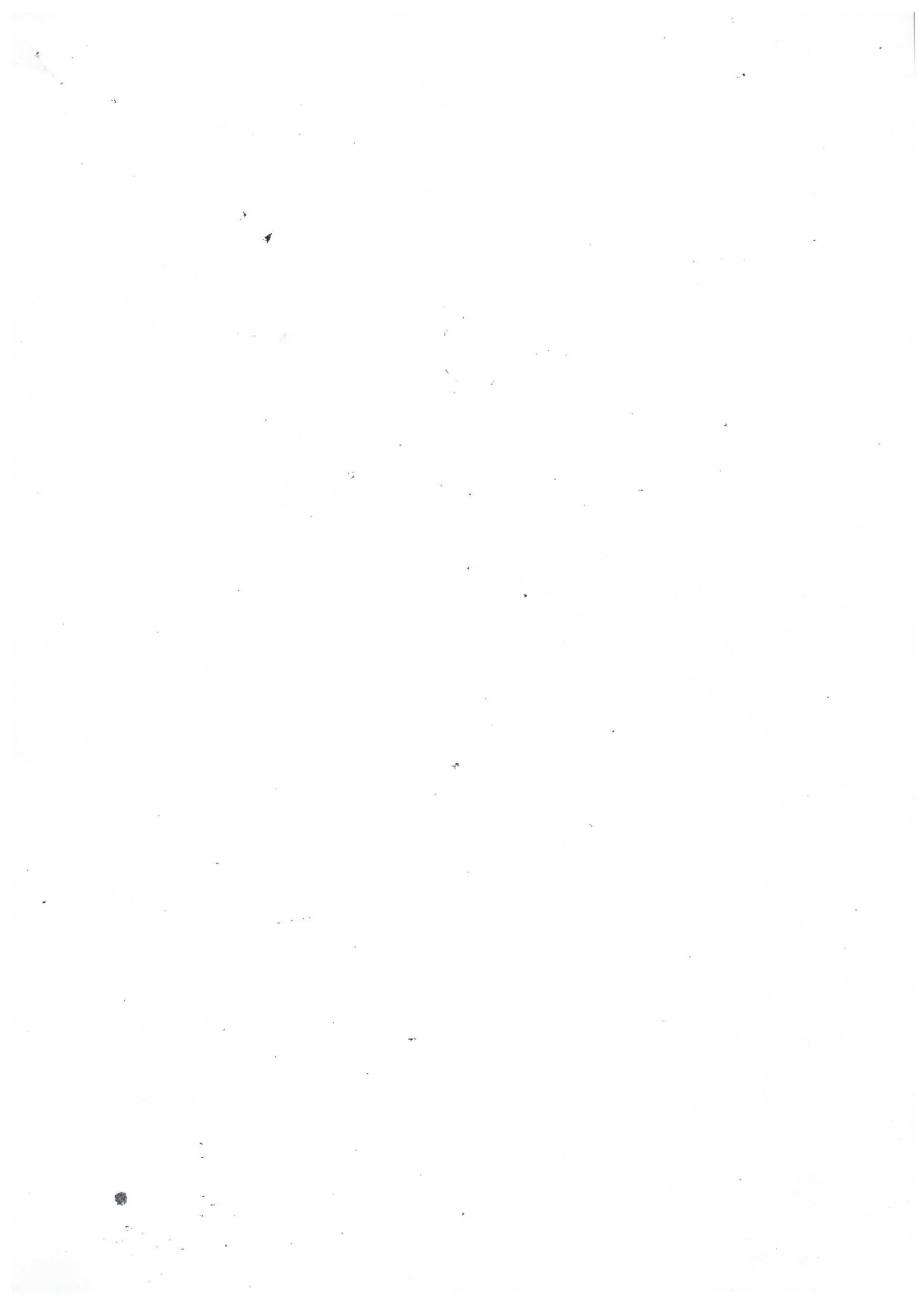
