ORDER:

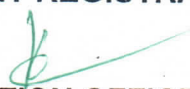
Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor takes notice for respondents 1 and 2 and seeks time to get instructions in the matter.

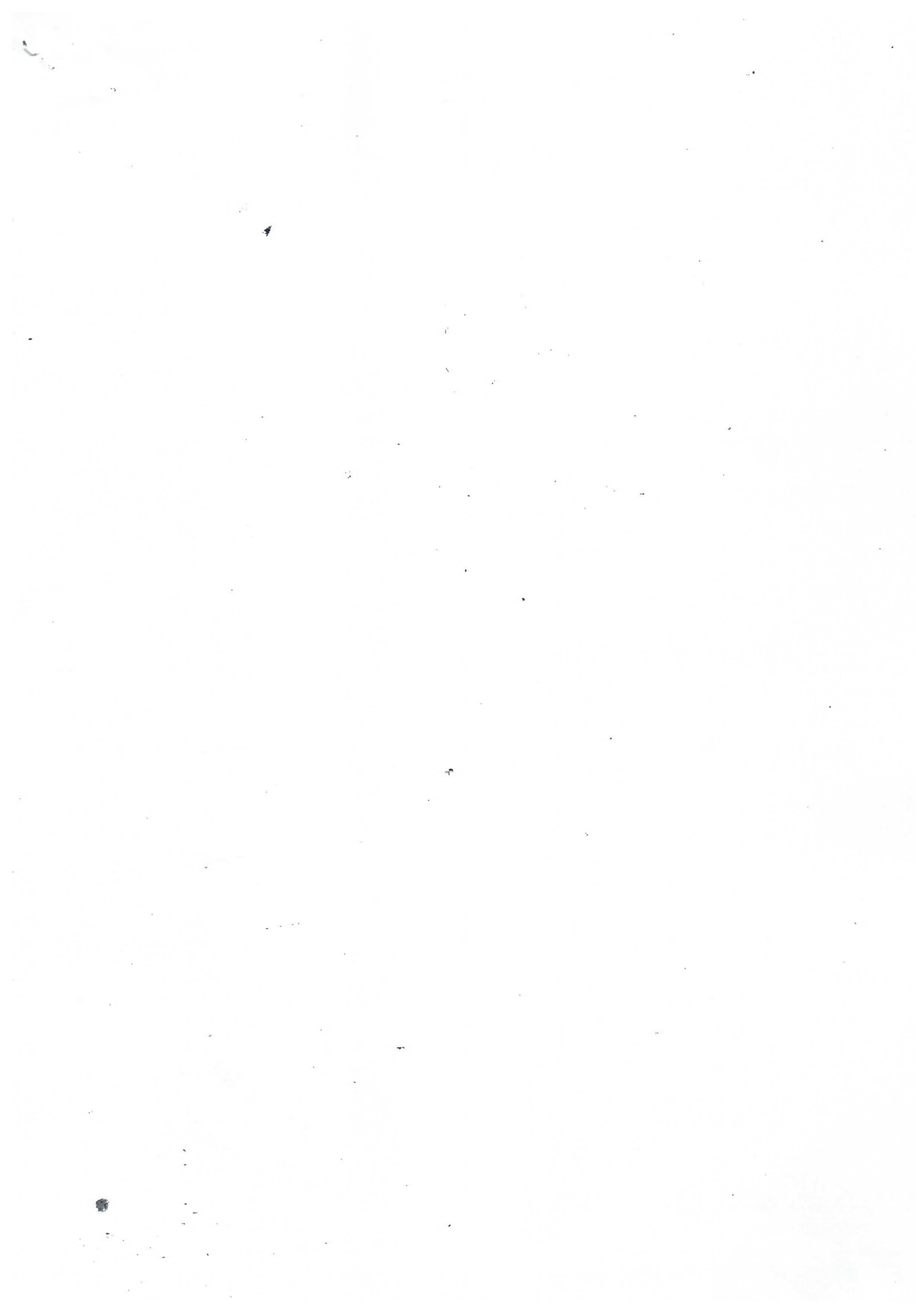
