ORDER

"Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of 1st Respondent and seeks time to get instructions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to 2nd Respondent by Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service within a period of three (3) weeks.

A perusal of material on record and charge sheet goes to show that, there is absolutely no specific accusation as against the petitioner herein. It is not even mentioned how the petitioner is related to A1.

In the circumstances stated above, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.363 of 2021 on the file of the learned Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Tiruvuru, in respect of petitioner only i.e., A4 only, for a period of eight (8) weeks.
