In the meanwhile, there shall be interim stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioner herein/A-7 only in CC No.1419 of 2022 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Special Mobile Court, Nellore, for a period of eight (8) weeks.

List the matter after six (6) weeks."
