In the meanwhile, there shall be interim stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioners herein only in CC No.2 of 2023 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Pathikonda, Kurnool district, for a period of eight (8) weeks.

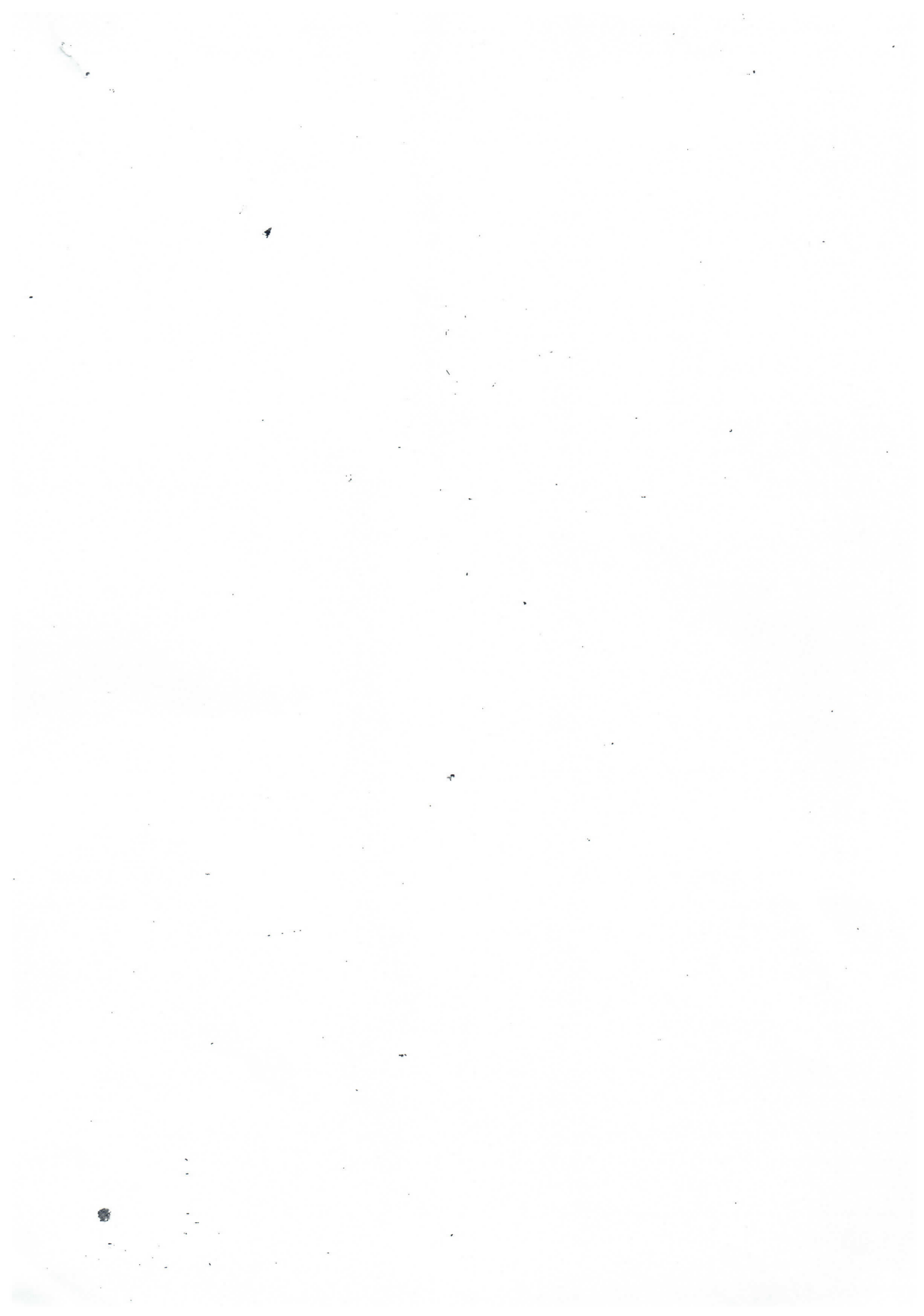
