Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by RPAD and file proof of service in the Registry within a period of three (3) weeks.

In the meanwhile, there shall be interim stay of all further proceedings including appearance of the petitioner herein only in CC No.5326 of 2022 on the file of the learned I Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Visakhapatnam, for a period of eight (8) weeks.
