The petitioner is accused No.5 in C.C.No.788 of 2022 on the file of the Additional Judicial Magistrate of First-Class, Anantapuramu District, for the offence under Section 498-A & 506 r/w. 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act. The petitioner contend that the allegations made against him in the charge sheet are general and omnibus allegations without any details as to specifics and as such, no case can be made against him. A perusal of the charge sheet does show that there are no specific allegations against the	

		petitioner except general and omnibus allegations of harassment. In the circumstances, the presence of the petitioner shall be dispensed with, till further orders in C.C.No.788 of 2022 on the file of the Additional Judicial Magistrate of First-Class, Anantapuramu District, except when his presence is required for examination.
