06	27.09.2023	<u>KSR,J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2023</u> Present application is filed by the petitioner/A.6, seeking to relax the condition imposed by this Court vide order dated 09.05.2023 in Crl.P.No.3021 of 2023. While granting anticipatory bail, this Court imposed a condition directing the petitioner/A.6 to appear before the Station House Officer concerned, on every Friday between 10.00 a.m. and 01.00 p.m. till filing of the charge sheet. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been complying with the condition imposed by this Court regularly without any default. He further contended that for the last four months he has been complying with the conditions. As such, he requests this Court to relax the said condition. On the other hand, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor, on instructions, states that right from the date of granting anticipatory bail, the petitioner is complying with the said condition without any default. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and for the reasons stated in the petition, this Court is inclined to relax the conditions imposed by this Court on 09.05.2023.	

Accordingly, this application is ordered and the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.P.No.3021 of 2023, vide order dated 09.05.2023, directing the petitioner/A.6 to appear before the Station House Officer concerned on every Friday between 10.00 a.m. and 1.00 p.m., is hereby relaxed.

However, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned as and when the petitioner's presence is required. In such event, the Investigation Officer is directed to issue a prior notice of one week for his appearance.
