Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to 1st Respondent by Registered Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service within a period of three (3) weeks.

A perusal of entire material on record goes to show that, an omnibus accusation against the petitioners herein i.e., A2 and A3 that they harassed the de facto complainant, no specific acts have been attributed as against them.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, presence of the petitioners herein/A2 and A3 before the trial Court has been dispensed with, except on those dates when the learned Magistrate, feels that the presence of petitioners herein/A2 and A3 is necessary.

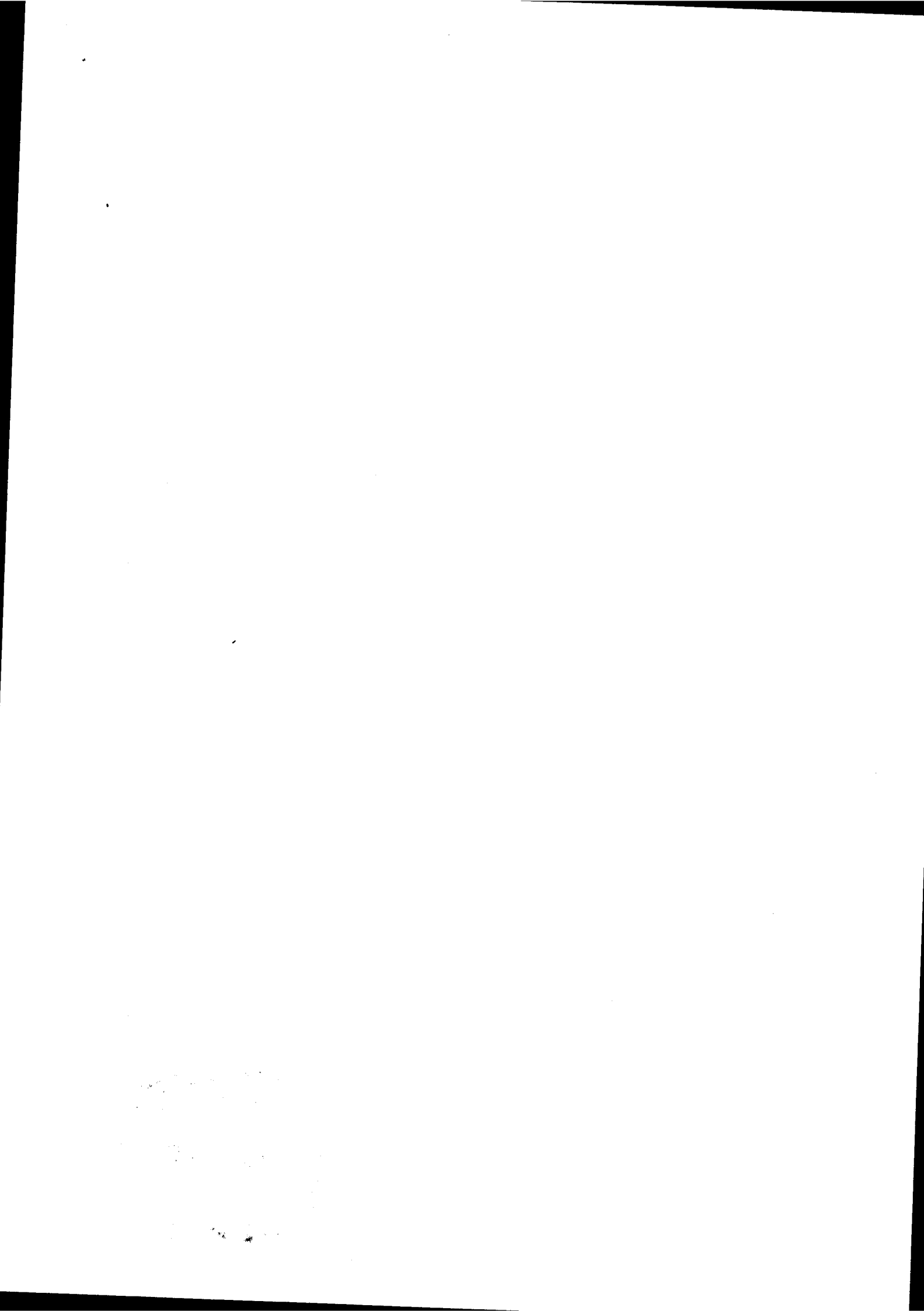
