Issue notice to the respondent No.2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner herein filed a suit in O.S.No.106 of 2013 against the <i>de facto</i> complainant and others for Permanent Injunction on the file of the Senior Civil Judge, Sattenapalli and during pendency of the said suit, the petitioner herein filed I.A.No.538 of 2013 and obtained Temporary Injunction in his favour restraining the respondents, their men, agents and relatives from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petition schedule property till the disposal of the suit. He submits that as a counterblast to that suit, the <i>de facto</i> complainant/2nd respondent herein gave report to the police against the petitioner herein. Police after conducting investigation filed charge sheet and the same was numbered as C.C.No.461 of 2018 on the	

		file of the I Additional Junior Civil Judge, Sattenapalli. Hence, the matter requires examination. Therefore, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.461 of 2018 pending on the file of the I Additional Junior Civil Judge, Sattenapalli, including the appearance of the petitioner herein, for a period of eight (8) weeks.
