By order, dated 24.08.2023, passed in Crl.P.No.6038 of 2023, this Court while granting bail to the petitioners/Accused Nos. 2, 4, 14 and 17 imposed the following condition:-</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">“the petitioners are directed not to enter into the limits of Venkatagiri Municipality and they are directed to report before the Station House Officer, III Town Police Station, Nellore, SPSR Nellore District, once in a week i.e., on every Sunday between 10.00 a.m., and 01.00 p.m., until further orders.”</p> <p>3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.</p> <p>4. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that right from date of release, the</p>	

petitioners have been regularly complying with the condition without any default.

5. On the other hand, the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor states there was no default on the part of the petitioners and they have been regularly complying with the condition.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances, the condition imposed by this Court directing them not to enter into the limits of Venkatagiri Municipality and they are directed to report before the Station House Officer, III Town Police Station, Nellore, SPSR Nellore District, once in a week i.e., on every Sunday between 10.00 a.m., and 01.00 p.m., until further orders is hereby relaxed.

7. However, it is made clear that the petitioners should appear before concerned investigating agency, as and when required by the investigating agency for the purpose of investigation. In that event, the investigating Officer invariably has to give one week prior notice to the petitioners.

8. Accordingly, this application is ordered.
