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		<u>IA.No.2 of 2023</u> The petitioner was found guilty for the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, convicted and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one year and to pay compensation of Rs.6,00,000/- and in default of payment of compensation, to suffer simple imprisonment for a period of three months, vide judgment dated 24.06.2022, passed in C.C.No.419 of 2018. The appeal preferred by the petitioner/ accused is dismissed confirming the conviction and sentence passed against him, vide judgment, dated 16.03.2023, in CrI.A.No.51 of 2022 of the learned III Additional Sessions Judge, Rajampet. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner/accused and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor appearing for the 1st respondent - State. Perused the material record. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the grounds urged in the revision, the petitioner has got fair chances of success in the revision.	

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		Having regard to the facts & submissions and the issues raised in the grounds of revision, which require detailed examination, the execution of sentence passed against the petitioner is suspended, pending final disposal of the revision, and the petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on his executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties in a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Rajampet, and also on condition of the petitioner depositing 25% of the compensation amount within a period of eight (8) weeks from today. In default of deposit of compensation amount, as ordered supra, the interim suspension granted today, shall stand cancelled automatically without further reference to the Court.
