

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE K.SURESH REDDY

CRIMINAL REVISION CASE No. 303 OF 2023

ORDER:

Questioning the order dated 29-03-2023 in C.F.No. 483 of 2023 in C.C.No. 992 of 2022 passed by learned Principal Judicial Magistrate of I Class, Nuzvid (for short, 'the Court below'), whereby the petition filed by the petitioner-accused No. 1 under Section 6 (2) (f) of the Passports Act, 1967, seeking to issue no objection certificate for issuance of passport, is rejected, the present criminal revision case is filed.

2. Today, when the matter is taken up, learned counsel for the petitioner-accused No. 1 submits that the main case, *i.e.* C.C.No. 992 of 2022, stands posted to 13-07-2023 for framing of charges and therefore requests this Court to direct the Court below to dispose of the main case itself instead of deciding the issue, whether or not no objection certificate has to be issued, in the present revision.

3. In view of the innocuous relief claimed by learned counsel for the petitioner-accused No. 1, this Court deems it appropriate to give a direction to the Court below to dispose of the main case within a timeframe.

4. Accordingly, the criminal revision case is disposed of with a direction to the Court below to take up trial in C.C.No. 992 of 2022 after framing charges and dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible and in any event not later than three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order without grating any undue adjournments to either of the parties. The petitioner-accused No. 1 is also directed to cooperate for early disposal of the case.

5. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in consequence.
