(13)	06.08.2024	<u>BSB, J</u> When the matter in C.R.P.No.1864 of 2023 is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioners has shown a certified copy of the evidence of a witness, by name, D. Lakshmi Narayana in E.A.No.24 of 2017 in O.S.No.1008 of 2016 on the file of the Court of II Additional Junior Civil Judge, Vijayawada, dated 22.11.2017 which is not readable as major part of it is blank and does not contain any legible letters. He further stated that all the five (5) certified copies issued are in the same manner. It appears that the concerned staffer has not followed the circular instructions of the High Court to issue a certify copy in a legible form. Therefore, the revision petitioner is instructed to return the certified copies for issue of a fresh legible copy as per the circular instructions of this Court. The Registrar (Judicial) is directed to get the earlier instructions regarding issue of legible certified copies re-circulated through for proper compliance in consonance with the true spirit of the circular instructions of this Court.	

The petitioner is directed to forthwith return the certified copy. Thereafter, a fairly legible certified copy shall be given to the applicant within three days of return.
