ORDER:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that pursuant to the directions of this Court, personal notice has been sent to the respondents in so far as the respondents 2 and 5 are concerned they were served and acknowledgments were filed. In so far as the 3rd respondent is concerned, it was returned with endorsement ‘refused’ and the notice sent to the 4th respondent is concerned also returned with endorsement ‘door locked,

intimation served'. Evidencing the same, a memo vide USR No.15816 of 2023, dated 13.02.2023 has been filed. Learned counsel for the petitioner requested permission of this Court to send fresh personal notice to the respondents 3 and 4 and also to the counsel appearing for them before the Court below.
