Petition under Section 151 of CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant temporary injunction in favor of the petitioner/appellant restraining the respondents and their men in any way interfering with his peaceful possession and enjoyment on the plaint schedule property in O.S. No. 142 OF 2009 on the file of Principal Junior Civil Judge, Tiruvuru, pending disposal of SA No. 308 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER:

“Notice.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the appellant that erroneously the appellate Court and the trial Court refused the injunction in favour of the plaintiff-appellant herein. It is further stated in the affidavit filed in support of the application that the trial Court granted temporary injunction and pending appeal before the 1st Appellate Court, the respondents did not interfere with the business and the possession of the appellant herein over the subject property. It is further stated that taking advantage of the dismissal of the First Appeal, the respondents are making hectic efforts to dispossess the petitioner from the plaint schedule property and that he is eking out his livelihood by running hotel business in the shed situated in the subject property.

Having regard to the above reasons, *status-quo* as regards the possession of the subject property shall be maintained pending further orders."
