Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to issue Provisional admission as per Rule 19 of A.P. (SC, ST & BC) Regulation of issuing of Community Certificate Act, 1993 and Rules 1997 to the petitioner in the admission counseling, certificate verification scheduled on 25.07.2023 or any other subsequent date for AP EAPCET-2023 (Engineering) held at Government Polytechnic college, Visakhapatnam, Pending disposal of WP No. 18539 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order. (The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER

“Heard Sri G.Tuhin Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Government Pleaders for Social Welfare, Revenue and the learned Standing counsel for respondent Nos.5 & 6.

The learned government Pleaders sought time for filing counter.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in similar facts and circumstances, this Court granted interim orders in W.P.No.16203 of 2023

and W.P.No.17375 of 2023 and prayed to pass similar orders on the ground of parity.

Perused the material available on record and considered the submissions made by both the learned counsel. Prima facie this Court finds a point for determination in the writ petition. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case and also the orders passed by this Court in W.P.Nos. 8654 of 2019 and 27589 of 2022, W.P.No.16203 of 2023 and W.P.No.17375 of 2023 and by Division Bench of this court in I.A.No.1 of 2019 in Writ Appeal No.188 of 2019, wherein similar set of facts and circumstances exist, this Court is inclined to grant the following direction:

“the concerned authorities are directed to issue provisional admission under Rule 19 of the A.P. (SC,ST & BC) Regulation of issuing of Community Certificate Act, 1993 forthwith. This interim arrangement shall be subject to outcome of this writ petition. It is, however made clear that the petitioner herein shall not claim any equities at the time of adjudication of the issue in the main writ petition.”
