Learned counsel for the respondent opposed to extend the time on the ground that the delivery warrant issued on 13.03.2023 by allowing E.P; at this stage, the extension of stay is not maintainable. Heard the learned counsel appearing on both sides. It is the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner/appellant that if the interim order is not extended, in execution proceedings, the delivery warrant will be issued, thereby, the very purpose of the second appeal will be defeated. Learned counsel for the appellant undertakes to argue the matter, if two weeks time is granted. Considering the submission made on behalf of the both sides, as the valuable rights of the properties are involved, the interim stay order is granted from this day until 20.09.2023.
