By order, dated 02.05.2023, passed in Crl.P.No.3026 of 2023, this Court while granting bail to the petitioner/Accused No.1 imposed the following condition:- “the petitioner shall appear before the Station House Officer concerned, once in a week i.e., on every Friday between 10.00 a.m., and 01.00 p.m., till filing of the charge sheet.” 3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. 4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that right from date of release, the petitioner has been regularly complying with the condition without any default.	

	5. On the other hand, the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor states there was no default on the part of the petitioner and he has been regularly complying with the condition. 6. Considering the facts and circumstances, the condition imposed by this Court directing him to report before the Station House Officer concerned, once in a week i.e., on every Friday between 10.00 a.m., and 01.00 p.m., till filing of the charge sheet is hereby relaxed. 7. However, it is made clear that the petitioner should appear before concerned investigating agency, as and when required by the investigating agency for the purpose of investigation. In that event, the investigating Officer invariably has to give one week prior notice to the petitioner. 8. Accordingly, this application is ordered. K SURESH REDDY,J RSI	
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
