Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to relax the condition to report before the SHO Drugi twice in a week i.e. on every Wednesday and Friday between 10.00 AM and 01.00 P.M vide its orders dt. 08-05-2023 passed in Crl.P No. 2951/2023, pending disposal of CRLP No. 2951 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the memorandum of grounds filed in support thereof and the earlier order of the High Court dated 08.05.2023 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Ancha Panduranga Rao, Advocate for the Petitioners and of Special Asst. Public Prosecutor for the Respondent, the Court made the following;

ORDER:

"Petitioners were shown as Accused Nos.3 to 6 in Crime No.25 of 2023 of Durgi Police Station, Palnadu District.

This Court, by order dated 08.05.2023 vide Criminal Petition No.2951 of 2023, granted anticipatory bail to the petitioners. However, while granting anticipatory bail, this Court directed the petitioners to report before Station

House Officer concerned twice in a week i.e., on every Wednesday and Friday between 10.00 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. till filing of charge sheet.

The present petition is filed seeking to relax the said condition of reporting before Station House Officer, Durgi Police Station.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are doing agriculture and in view of the commencement of monsoon season, they are finding it very difficult to appear before police on every Wednesday and Friday.

On the other hand, learned Special Assistant Public Prosecutor, on instructions, states that the petitioners have been complying with the said condition regularly without any default.

In view of the above circumstances, I.A.No.2 of 2023 is ordered and the condition imposed by this Court directing the petitioners to report before Station House Officer, Durgi Police Station on every Wednesday and Friday between 10.00 a.m. and 1.00 p.m., is hereby relaxed."
