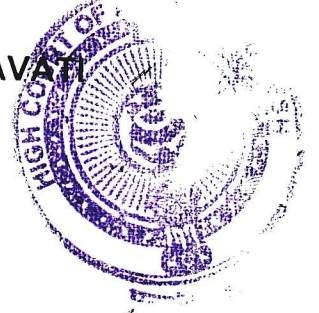

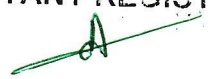
ORDER

Having regard to the reasons assigned in the affidavit filed in support of this interlocutory application as well as the grounds raised in the appeal, pending further orders, there shall be interim stay of all further proceedings in pursuance of the judgment and decree dated 17.10.2022 passed in M.V.O.P.No.103 of 2018 by the Motor Vehicle Accidents Claims Tribunal-cum-I Additional District Judge’s Court, Kadapa, subject to condition of the appellant depositing 50% of the compensation awarded along with interest and costs, within a period of eight weeks from today. On such deposit being made, respondent No.1/claimant is permitted to withdraw the amount so deposited in terms of the impugned judgment.”
