Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ Order or direction particularly, one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 2nd respondent, in not disposing the application dated 25/08/2022 despite of completion of more than 90 days is nothing but violation of fundamental rights of person guaranteed under the Constitution of India and is contrary to Section 5(4) of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and senior citizens Act, 2007 (Act 56 of 2007) as illegal, arbitrary and violation of principles of natural justice and also violations of Article 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 2nd respondents to dispose of the application dated 25/08/2022 expeditiously in accordance with law.
