WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri SUBBA RAO KORRAPATI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order, or direction more particularly in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the proceedings SWC/E1/1022/2022-3, dt.05-12-2022 issued by 2nd Respondent by disposing the representation that the petitioner is not entitled for interest on delayed payment of retirement benefits and not paying the Productivity Linked Incentives is arbitrary, illegal, Colorable of Exercise of Power and in violation of Art 14,16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and GOs issued by the Government of AP, and to quash or set aside the same and to issue a consequential direction to the 2nd Respondent to pay interest as entitled by the petitioner for delay of 15 months in settling the retirement benefits and also the Productivity Linked Incentive to the petitioner for the period 2016-2017 forthwith.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Subba Rao Korrapati, Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for Agriculture and Cooperation for the Respondent No.1 and Sri S.Rajeswar Reddy, Standing Counsel for the Respondent Nos.2 & 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

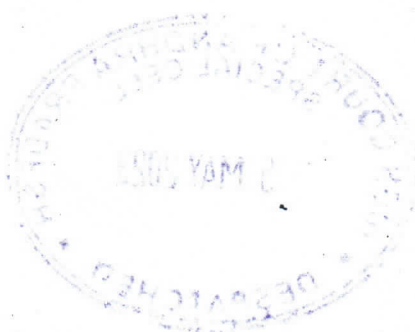
