Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased topleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of respondents in not paying bill amounts towards the cost of material supplied and skilled 85 semi-skilled labour engaged by the petitioner for execution of 1) Work Code No. 0209030009/RC/7707010080035 for an amount of Rs. 6,60,782/- and ii) Work Code No. 0209030009/RC/7707010080036 for an amount of Rs. 5,88,483/- 85 Rs. 64,542/- as illegal, arbitrary, irresponsible, against to the principles of natural justice apart from being violative of Article 21 of the Constitution of India and consequentially direct the respondents to pay the above amounts forthwith along with interest in the interest of justice and pass

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Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to pay the bill amounts towards the cost of material supplied and skilled and semi-skilled labour engaged by the petitioner for execution of i) Work Code No. 0209030009/RC/7707010080035 for an amount of Rs. 6,60,782/- and ii) Work Code No. 0209030009/RC/7707010080036 for an amount of Rs. 5,88,483/- and Rs. 64,542/-, pending disposal of the main Writ Petition and pass
