3.	13.07.2023	<u>NJS, J</u> At the time of considering the matter, the Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Land Acquisition placed a copy of the Communication of the 6th respondent dated 27.04.2023. From a reading of which, it would appear that there is no dispute with regard to the <i>ex gratia</i> amount of Rs.79,76,000/- payable to the petitioner and the Bill was submitted to CFMS Portal in time. However, the Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that so far the amount has not been paid to the petitioners. Considered the submissions made. In view of the above said position and as there is no dispute with regard to entitlement of the petitioner for payment of the said amount, there shall be a direction to the respondent Nos.2 to 7 to arrange to pay the same, as expeditiously as possible, at any rate, within a period of six (6) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. So far as the interest component is concerned, the Learned Assistant Government Pleader submits that the petitioners are not entitled to. The matter requires consideration on that aspect after filing of Counters. List this case after six (6) weeks for filing Counters of the respondents. <u>NJS, J</u> IS
