Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, direction or order, particularly one in the nature of Mandamus declaring the notices dated 11-4-2023 issued under Sec 596 of the Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Act, 1955 as arbitrary, illegal, unjust and against Article 16 (1)(g) and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently (i) set aside the notices dated 11- 4-2023 and (ii) further direct the respondents not to interfere with the vocation of the petitioners in pig rearing.

IA NO: 1 OF 2023

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the operation of the notices dated 11-4-2023 issued by the 3rd respondent under Sec 596 of the Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Act, 1955 to the petitioners herein, Pending disposal of WP 11170 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

IA NO: 2 OF 2023

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the WRIT petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents herein to refrain from forcefully taking

away the pigs and leaving them in the forest or kill the pigs being reared by the petitioners herein, Pending disposal of WP 11170 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.
