2)	24.06.2025	<u>CGR, J.</u> <u>I.A.No.2 of 2023</u> This Court has passed interim order, dated 01.05.2023, suspending the Award in I.D.No.20 of 2018, dated 11.07.2022, passed by the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Ananthapuramu, till the next date of hearing. Now, this vacate stay petition has been filed by the 1st respondent-workman. 2. Learned counsel for the 1st respondent/workman submits that in similar cases, this Court has passed interim orders of suspension of Award subject to the workman being reinstated into service and therefore, seeks to modify the interim order, dated 01.05.2023 accordingly. 3. Learned Standing Counsel appearing for the writ petitioners-Corporation does not refute the same. 4. In view of the same, the vacate stay petition is disposed of by modifying the interim order passed earlier. The Award passed in I.D. No.20 of 2018, dated 11.07.2022, passed by the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Ananthapuramu, is stayed subject to workman being reinstated into service within six weeks from	

the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
