Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order, or Direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondent Authorities in interfering and taking steps to demolish the fence and the internal roads (developments) in the Petitioners land total ad-measuring Ac. 2-83 Cents (Old Sri Ravi Rice Mill) situated in R.S.Nos. 92-2, 92-6, 92-7 of Elamanchili Village and Mandal, West Godavari District without there being any power much less authority and without notice and hearing and also following due process of law as illegal, arbitrary and violative of principles of natural justice and violative of Articles 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the Respondent Authorities not to cause any demolition also interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the Petitioner in the subject property without recourse to the procedure established under the law.

**IA NO: 1 OF 2023**

Petition under Section 151 CPC is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents not to demolish the fence and the internal roads (developments) or interfere with the Petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment in respect of the Petitioners land total ad-measuring Ac. 2-83 Cents (Old Sri Ravi Rice Mill) situated in R.S.Nos. 92-2, 92-6, 92-7 of Elamanchili Village and Mandal, West Godavari District, Pending disposal of WP 11724 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the earlier Order of the High Court dt. 04.05.2023 & 11.05.2023 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Rambabu Koppineedi Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Panchayat Raj Rural Dev for the Respondent Nos. 1,3,5 & 8, GP for Revenue for the Respondent Nos. 2,4 & 6, GP for Home for the Respondent Nos. 10 & 11, Sri N.Srihari, Counsel for the Respondent Nos. 7 & 9, the Court made the following:

**ORDER:**
