01.	12.05.2023	<u>DR, J</u> Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that initially, as per G.O.Ms. No.131, dated 15.09.2021 the authorities have recommended for construction of Primary Health Center [PHC] at Metturu village; accordingly, they have identified the land and proposals were also accorded by the concerned District Collector; while that being so, surprisingly for no reasons, the respondents have inclined to shift the construction of PHC to Yenniramannapeta village, contrary to the G.O.Ms.No.131. Learned Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the respondents, on instructions submitted that though the authorities identified the land initially at Metturu village, while allotting the same to the construction of PHC it was brought to the notice of the authorities about non-payment of compensation/ objection raised by the land owners, hence the authorities have identified the other land. 		Replying to the same, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in fact, there is alternative land available for the PHC in the said village but instead of availing the same, the respondents, on extraneous reasons, shifted the PHC to some other village.
