The detainee categorically asserts that she does not want to live with her mother, children etc and would like to spend her time with Sri Bhanu Murthy only. The children, mother and the natural brother of detainee on the other hand state that she is subjected to emotional black mail through whatsapp messages etc. As a result of which she wants to live with Bhanu Murthy. It is also mentioned in the course of discussion that detainee underwent some psychiatric evaluation in Abhaya Hospital, Bangalore. The file produced has a certain description of the anxiety and the other issues that she is suffering from. Both the parties are very clear and have categorical stands. This Court is of the opinion that further hearing and also investigation is necessary since the allegations are that the detainee is unsafe with both Bhanu Murthy and also with mother and children. In that view of the matter, the State	

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		represented by respondent No.1 is directed to keep interim custody of Smt.Usha/detenuue in Swadhar Home, Mahila pranganam compound, near Collectorate Bungalow, Guntur for a period of one month. In this period of one month, they are also directed to get proper medical psychiatric evaluation for her mental stage. The medical report should be produced before this Court.
