Also heard learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, who seeks time to secure written instructions in the matter. A perusal of the material filed along with the Writ Petition would go to show that in respect of the subject matter property, the petitioner filed W.P No.576 of 2023 and by an order dated 06.01.2023 a direction was issued to respondents not to take any coercive action in respect of the subject matter land without following due process of law. The petitioner subsequently, filed another Writ Petition vide W.P No.9611 of 2023 and an order of status-quo was granted on 19.04.2023 and the same was extended by an order dated 25.04.2023 till 30.06.2023. Despite the said orders from a perusal of the impugned proceedings dated 05.06.2023, it would appear that without issuing any notice and following due process of law Possession Certificate has been cancelled. (P.T.O)
