Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents in issuing Notice dated 17-11-2022 vide R.C No.1318/2019/F and also publishing Declaration Vide R.C.No. 1318/2019(F) dated 13-08-2022 and issuing preliminary Notice vide Rc.No.G1/4982 /2019 dated -12-2021 and proceedings to acquire the Houses of the Petitioner bearing No. D. No. 5-629 and 5-628 with an extent of 235 Sq.yards in Sanjaya Nagar, Dharmavaram, Sri Satya Sai District as, illegal, arbitrary, violation of Principles of Natural Justice, violation of settled principles of law and violation of Articles 14, 19(1)(g), 21 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently set-aside the same .

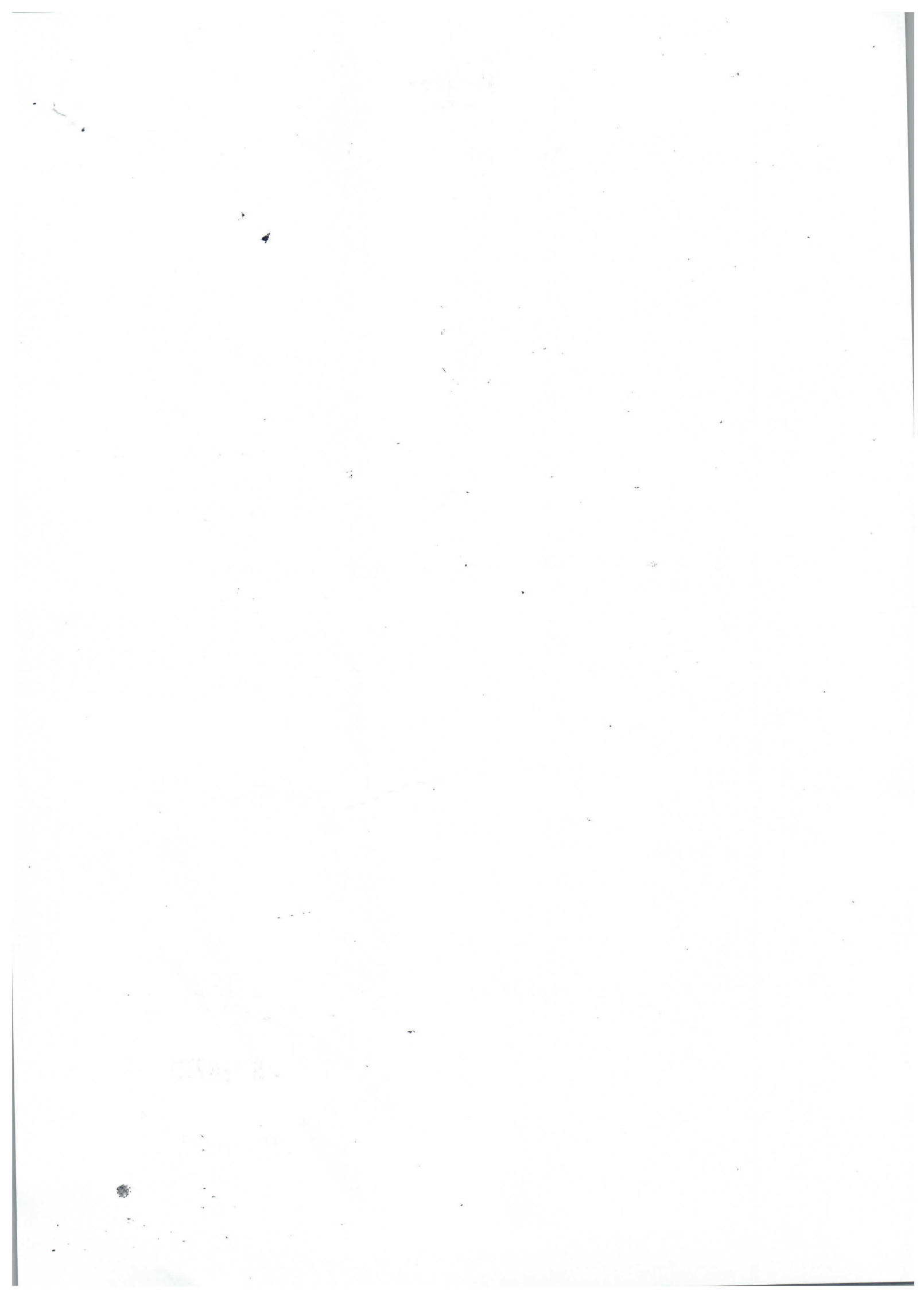
