Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the inaction of respondents particularly respondents 3 and 6 on petitioner's representation dated 31.12.2022, submitted to promote her in the vacant post of Anganwadi Worker in Ananthapalli Anganwadi Centre code No.27 of Ananthapalli Village in Nallajerla Mandal of East Godavari District, by implementing Memo.No.16037/15/2018-1, dated 13.12.2018 issued by the by 2nd respondent, as illegal, irregular, unjust, arbitrary, violative of principles of natural justice, contrary to the settled principles of service jurisprudence and offends Articles 14 and 21 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to promote petitioner as Anganwadi Worker in the said Anganwadi Center,

concerned and consequently direct the respondents to promote the petitioner into that post, Pending disposal of WP 1501 of 2023, on the file of the High Court.

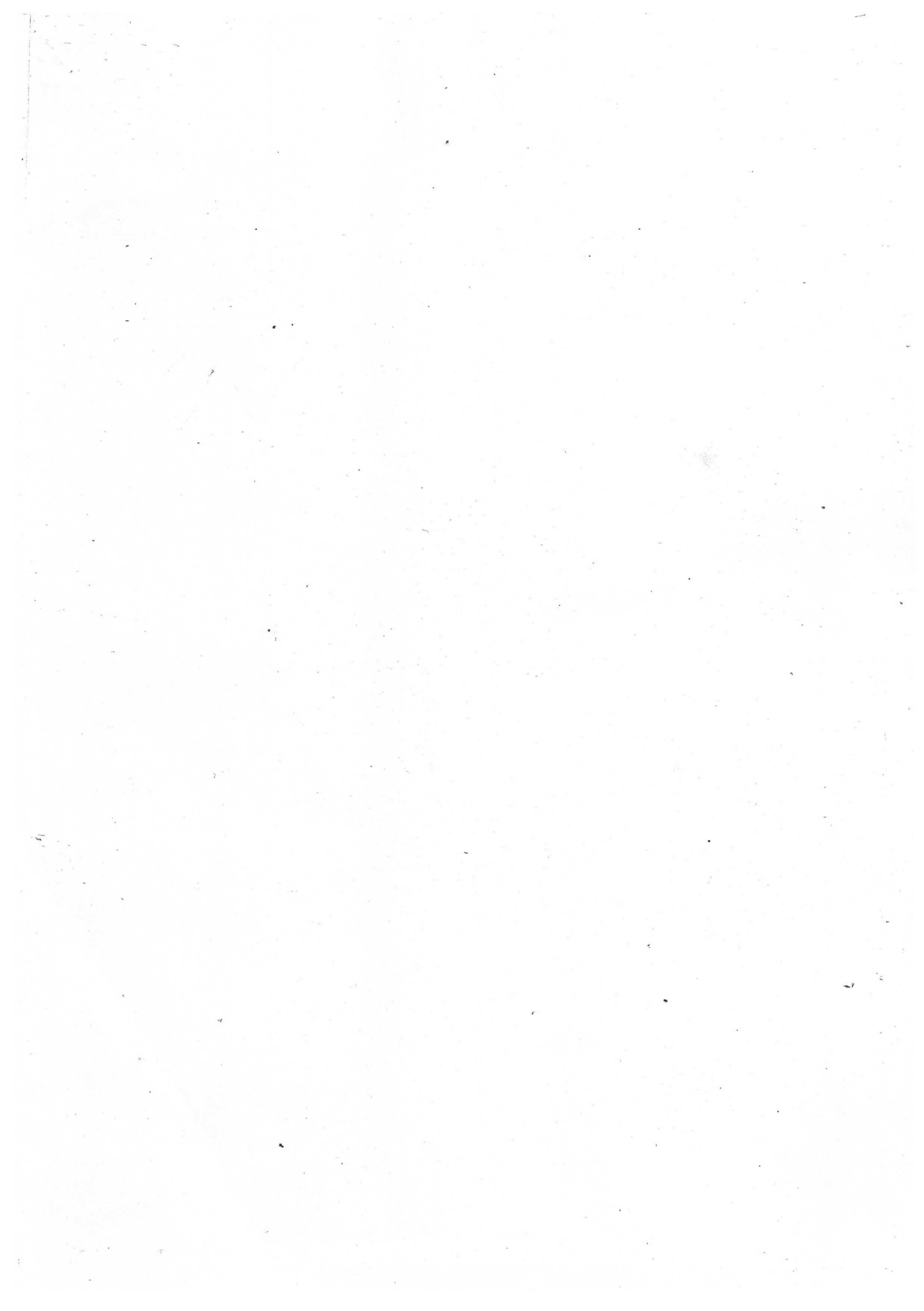
