The Court made the following:**ORDER:**

This Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India with the following prayer for:

“.... to issue an order, direction, or a writ, more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Certiorari, to call for the records in Cr. No. 19/2023 dated 14/01/2023 of the Gajuwaka PS., Visakhapatnam and

declare the same as collusive, false, criminalizing a civil dispute by abusing the powers vested in the 3rd and 4th respondents under Cr.P.C., 1973 and consequently quash the FIR in Cr. No. 19/2023 dated 14/01/2023.”

2. Heard Sri V.V. Ravi Prasad, learned counsel for the petitioners and Sri Ajay Babu, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home would submit that investigation is completed in this matter and charge sheet is also filed against the petitioners and the same was taken on file as C.C.No.219 of 2023 on the file of the learned III Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Gajuwaka.

4. In that view, the Writ Petition is disposed of. However, the petitioners are at liberty to file a fresh application before appropriate forum in accordance with law, if so advised. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.
