ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for the respondents.

2. The grievance of the petitioner in the present writ petition, in short, is that despite making F-Line application on 15.3.2023 seeking to conduct survey and demarcate the land of an extent of Acs.6.52 cents in Survey No.684 of Tadigotla Village, Chinthakommadinne Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, after excluding the land taken possession for formation of Airport, no steps have been taken by the respondents so far.

3. When an application is made seeking for survey and fixation of boundaries, the concerned Tahsildar is required to take appropriate decision in terms of Section 10(1) of the Andhra Pradesh Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923 and intimate the decision thereon to the parties under Section 10(2) of the said Act. The legal position in this regard has been succinctly dealt with in the orders dated 19.2.2020 by a learned Judge of this Court in Writ Petition No.2674 of 2020. In view of the same, the 4th respondent is directed to take appropriate action on the petitioner's F-Line application dated 15.3.2023, and intimate the decision under Section 10(1) and Section 10(2) of the said Act respectively, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No order as to costs. As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
