ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for the respondents. With the consent of both sides the writ petition is being disposed of at the stage of admission.

2. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the grievance of the petitioner is that despite making application for survey of land in question by paying challan on 07.02.2023; no steps have been taken by the respondents so far.

3. When an application is made seeking for survey and fixation of boundaries, the concerned Tahsildar is required to take appropriate

decision in terms of Section 10(1) of the Andhra Pradesh Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923 and intimate the decision thereon to the parties under Section 10(2) of the said Act. The legal position in this regard has been succinctly dealt with in the orders dated 19.02.2020 by a learned Judge of this Court in Writ Petition No.2674 of 2020. In view of the same, the 4th respondent is directed to take appropriate action on the petitioner's recent application dated 07.02.2023 and intimate the decision under Section 10(1) and Section 10(2) of the said Act respectively, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No order as to costs. As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
