Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased topleased to issue an order, writ or direction more particularly in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondent Nos.2 to 5 in not considering the petitioner representation dt.24.12.2022 and entering into the petitioner legally possessed property coercively and laying a CC Road in the petitioner private patta land in Sy.No.84/4 to an extent of Ac.0.09 cents and Sy.No.84/8B to an extent of Ac.0.09 cents situated at Aalapakam Village, Vijayapuram Mandal, Chittoor District is as illegal, arbitrary, violation of natural justice and violation of Articles 14 and 300A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 3rd respondent to suspend the operation of laying CC Road in Sy.No.84/4 to an extent of Ac.0.09 cents and Sy.No.84/8B to an extent of Ac.0.09 cents situated at Aaiapakam Village, 'Vijayapuram iviandai, Chittoor District and consider the petitioner representation dt.24.12.2022 to the 3rd respondent and pass

The Court made the following:

ORDER

This writ petition is filed questioning the action of respondent nos.2 to 5 in attempting to lay CC road in the private patta land of the petitioner in Survey Nos.84/4 and 84/8B situated at Aalapakam Village, Vijayapuram Mandal, Chittoor District, without considering the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 24.12.2022.

2. Sri M.Sudheer, learned Standing counsel, on the written instructions of the Panchayat Secretary, Aalapakam Grampanchayat, submitted that pursuant to the representation submitted by the petitioner, the authorities have examined the records available in their office and having found that the subject land in Survey No.84/4 and 84/8B is classified as patta land, the Gram Panchayat has stopped laying road in the said survey numbers.

3. In view of the submission made by the learned Standing Counsel, nothing remains for adjudication in this writ petition and the same can be closed.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.
