Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ of Mandamus, or other appropriate writ, order or direction, the action of the 3rd respondent herein in entertaining the Appeal in Rc.No.DT(A)/43/2022 (Rc.No.D2/42/2023) filed by the Respondent No.5 to 12 under ROR Act in respect of land an extent of Ac.12.92 cents in Sy.No.39/A, an extent of Ac.8.49 cents in Sy.No.39/C and an extent of Ac.25.93 cents in Sy.No.45 of Ramagiri Village, Pamidi Mandal, Ananthapuramu District as illegal, arbitrary, without jurisdiction and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India besides violative of Principles of Natural Justice contrary to the provisions Andhra Pradesh Rights in Land and Pattadar Pass Books Act, 1971 and to pass such other order or orders.

ORDER:

The Writ Petition is filed challenging the action of the 3rd respondent – Revenue Divisional Officer, in entertaining the Appeal in Rc.No.DT(A)/43/2022 [Rc.No.D2/42/2023), filed by the unofficial respondent Nos.5 to 12.

Pending consideration of the Writ petition, the 3rd respondent vide proceedings in Rc.No.DT(A)/43/2022 [Rc.No.D2/43/2023], has rendered a judgment / order dated 06.01.2026 and rejected the appeal filed by the unofficial respondent Nos.5 to 12.
