2.	30.01.2023	<u>BKM, J</u> Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader for Mines and Geology for the respondents. This writ petition is filed questioning the Memo of the 1st respondent dated 20.12.2022 in disposing of the revision application. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the remand of the matter to the revisional authority by this Hon'ble Court in the earlier round of litigation, the notice was issued by the revisional authority fixing the date as 16.11.2022, but the learned counsel for the petitioner filed a Memo on 16.11.2022 seeking time to file vakalat, to receive all the papers from the authority and proceed with the matter in revision. Ignoring the same, the revisional authority proceeded with the matter, as if, the petitioner proceeded with the proceedings and observed that the earlier proceedings of the revision dated 10.02.2022 holds good.	

		On the other hand, the learned Government Pleader for Mines and Geology seeks time to file a detailed counter affidavit. In view of the same, as the petitioner on facts stated that no opportunity was given in spite of remanding the matter with such a direction to enable the petitioner to participate in the said proceedings and the revisional authority without considering the Memo dated 16.11.2022 of the petitioner, passed the impugned proceedings which shows that <i>prima facie</i> there is some force in the contention of the petitioner. In view of the same, the 2nd respondent is directed not to take any coercive steps pursuant to the impugned proceedings of the 1st respondent dated 20.12.2022, pending further orders. List on 27.02.2023. In the meanwhile, counters shall be filed by the respondents. _____ BKM, J PGT	
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
